Subject :- Grant of Extended Permission Vasant Dada Patil Ayurved Medical College, Sangli- Miraj Road , South Shivaji Nagar, Sangli- 416416, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0146) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27-reg.

Sir/Madam,

1. To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college and inspection was conducted on **06.05.2026 and 07.05.2026 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the permission with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27.**
2. The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report shortcomings/defects were observed and same was placed in the 161st Board meeting of MARBSIM held on 28.07.2026 and Board decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to your college.**
3. In view of above an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBSIM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no. dated 30.07.2026** was granted to your college to appear on **04.08.2026** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to **show cause as to why not the permission to your college with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied.**
4. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter. Ref. No. VPAMC/586/2026-27 dated 31.07.2026** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Principal of the college Dr. Vishwajeet Mhetre and Vice-Principal Dr. Ashish Pudkar** appeared before the Hearing Committee on **04.08.2026** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college.
5. Thereafter, observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms regulations, namely, "Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024, and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020, the observation of Hearing Committee was placed in the **170th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **11.08.2026 and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations and decided to issue extended permission in accordance with regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda regulations, 2024, under section 28 of NCISM Act.**

"DECISION"

6. **Therefore, Extended permission is hereby granted to Vasant Dada Patil Ayurved Medical College, Sangli- Miraj Road , South Shivaji Nagar, Sangli- 416416, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0146) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 as per the provision under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2026-27 subject to condition that the aforementioned shortcomings shall be fulfilled along with the following conditions:-**
 - I. **Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2026-27 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

7. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
8. Further, as **per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
9. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
10. **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. Ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
11. **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2026 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-2028:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled,
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024,
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-28.

Note:- It is also noted that, if the concerned University does not grant affiliation to the college or withdraws the affiliation, the permission granted by MARBISM shall automatically stand withdrawn without any further notice or order.
